

## Introduction to Daisies

### First Ever Meeting

2.45pm Start

2.50 Girls settled on the mat

2.55 Kaper Chart Allocation

3.00 Snack

3.10 Stand in a circle - wool game

Have a large ball of wool/yarn, & give to a Daisy. She has to throw it to another Daisy while saying that Daisy's name. She then keeps hold of the wool/yarn and the Daisy with the ball of yarn throws it to another Daisy while calling out yet another Daisy name. She then holds onto her section of the yarn, until all the girl's names have been called & they have all caught the yarn.

You end up in a complete mess, loads of giggling girls and they get to know each other's names!

3.15 Introduce Daisies - What do Daisies do?

#### **HELP Chart.**

Give each Daisy an envelope with a picture of someone/something whom they can help. Ask them, in turn to say how they could help that person/thing. This encourages them to feel comfortable speaking in front of their fellow Daisies, while thinking about what GS is all about...helping others. Stick their picture up on a chart for all to see.

3.25 Talk about the Daisy Promise & Law ...lead on to Craft

## CRAFT

**1** - Draw around their hand & cut out. Fold down the fingers (Pinkie & thumb) that make the GS promise sign. Stick it on a piece of paper with the Promise already printed on it.

**2** - Make a card (size A2) let the Daisy draw anything on them! Inside write the message **“A Daisy was here”** Ask the Daisies to take these cards home and when they have done a good deed like tidying up, folding clothes, cleaning bathroom etc. place their card in that spot saying **‘A Daisy was here’**. :-)
